Pre War:

Born in Cheshunt about 1898, 1911 Census shows the family living in Sudbury, Middlesex. Father William Ernest UGLOW, Mother Florence Annie UGLOW, he had 3 sisters and 4 brothers. At the time of his death, the family had probably moved back to the Cheshunt area and were living in Beaumont View.

He was living in Holborn. He enlisted in London and 4.11.14 went to France.

Wartime Service:

Embarked for France on 4th November 1914, survived less than a month.
