Pre War:

Born in 1874 in Colkirk, Norfolk, son of Rev Walter Marsham and Jessie (Robertson) Hoare later of Milton House, Berkhamsted. He was living in the Rectory in Colkirk in 1891 and was at school at Eton. He married Elsie Florence Hogg in Marylebone, London on 5 Nov 1901 and had five children. A bankers agent to his cousin Edward Hoare in the City, he was living in 37 Fleet Street, London in 1911.

Wartime Service:

He entered France on 24 Dec 1914 with the 28th Division which was deployed to the front line of the Western Front around Ypres.
