Pre War:

Leonard attended Hitchin Boys British School. He was married to Ethel St. John and their home was at Willbury Cottages, Willbury Hills, near Hitchin. They had no children. He was the brother of Ernest Arnold Grant.

Wartime Service:

He enlisted in Hitchin and was allocated the Corps Number 151837 and posted to the S.S.T.C. - RE.

He died in Barnet Hospital during a leave period, four days after his mother's death. Both of them died of pneumonia resulting from the influenza epidemic that was raging throughout the country at the time.

He was buried in Hitchin Cemetery Grave S VIIIB.
