He was the son of George and Emma Tansley of 6, Park St. Hitchin and was the husband of Annie Margaret Tansley of 60, Bunyan Rd, Hitchin. Another address shown for him, probably later, was 12 Cannon's Gardens, Hitchin.

Wartime Service:

George was given the Regimental Number G/21063 in the 3rd Battalion of the Regiment. He died in hospital in the United Kingdom. He was buried in Hitchin Cemetery in Grave 741, South East Extension. In 1997 no memorial could be identified on the grave site.
