Pre War:

Born in 1887 in 25 London Road, Hertford Heath son of Arthur and Alice Brace, living in 4 Western Terrace, Hailey Brickfield, Great Amwell in 1901 and later in Rye House, Hoddesdon. He married Margaret E. Wooldridge (later Mrs. Perry of Milly Bridge, Waltham St. Lawrence, Twyford, Berks) in 1913 in Hertford.

Wartime Service:

Enlisted at Ware and was already abroad with his battalion in 1911. He was killed in action.

Additional Information:

Brother of Private Douglas Brace who died on 30 Sep 1916 and is also commemorated on these memorials.
