Pre War:

Born in 1887 in Broxbourne son of James and Hariett Cornhill and living in Spital Brook, Hoddesdon in 1891. He married Ada Jessie Durrant on 20 Oct 1910 in Ware and lived in 36 South Street, Stanstead Abbots, Ware, Herts with three children. He was a nursery man.

Wartime Service:

Enlisted at Stanstead Abbots on 29 Nov 1915, mobilised on 30 May 1916 and embarked at Folkestone on 24 Oct 1916 and was killed in action on the Somme.

Additional Information:

Brother of Private Herbert Charles Cornhill who died of wounds on 22 Apr 1918 and of Private William Cornhill who died of wounds on 29 Mar 1918 and who are also commemorated on these memorials.
