### **Pre War:**

Born on 27 Oct 1889 in Whitley Road, Hoddesdon son of Alfred and Belinda (Bowden) Fuller and later lived in 11 Laurel Villas, New Road, Bedfont, Middlesex. He was employed on the Metropolitan Railway.

### **Wartime Service:**

Enlisted on 13 May 1912 in the Territorial Force, volunteered for foreign service and embarked at Southampton on 8 Mar 1915 on the SS Empress Queen and entered France. He was killed in action at Zonnebeke in the Battle for Hill 60.
