Pre War:

Born on 5 Aug 1888 in Eltham, Kent son of Edmonds and Catherine (McTaggart) Massey and lived in North Park, Eltham in 1891 and later in Yew Arbour, High Street, Hoddesdon. He had emigrated to Canada where he was a farmer.

Wartime Service:

He had been serving in the 19th St Catherine's Rifles before the war and enlisted for the Canadian Overseas Expeditionary Force on 16 Nov 1915 at Calgary, Alberta, Canada. He was killed in action in the trenches SW of Passchendaele.
