He married Kate Hadley on 27 Nov 1898 in Wandsworth and they lived in 61 Fairfield Street, Wandsworth, London and had three children.

Wartime Service:

Enlisted at London and in 1911 he was already in the Cavalry Barracks in Colchester. Served in England and died in Farnham, Surrey falling off a horse.
