Born 2 May 1898 in Burnt Mill, Netteswell, Essex son of Edward and Emily (Wyatt) Seabury and was living in Albert Villa, Station Road, Broxbourne in 1911 and later in "Garth", Broxbourne. He was a bank clerk and was unmarried.

Wartime Service:

Enlisted in May 1916 formerly as Private 492430 but obtained a commission on 8 May 1917 and entered France on 5 Jul 1917. He was killed in action near St Julien by shrapnel while leading his platoon in an attack..
