ADAMSON, GORDON VICTOR. School period: September, 1907, to July, 1913. Rifleman, Queen Victoria's Rifles. Died in Cambridge Military Hospital, 3rd May, 1915.

ADKINS, ALAN KEITH. School period: September, 1906, to July, 1913. Private, 4th Royal Sussex Regiment. Four years. Egypt, Palestine and France.

AISH, GEORGE. School period: October, 1900, to June, 1902. Lance-Corporal, Civil Service Rifles. Enlisted in April, 1915, and went to France in October; in December was wounded and spent four months in a base hospital; took part in the attacks on Vimy Ridge and on the Somme; killed by a shell while helping to consolidate captured ground, 15th September, 1916.

AISH, WILLIAM. School period: September, 1905, to March, 1910. Sergeant, R.E. Served in France and Belgium from November, 1914, until April, 1919.

ANDREWS, REGINALD MAURICE. School period: September, 1908, to July, 1915. Private, R.A.S.C. (M.T.). Two years, six months. France.

ANKER, ALLEN MUGGLETON. School period: September, 1909, to March, 1914. 2nd Class Air Mechanic, R.N.A.S. ANNEAR, RICHARD WILLIAM. School period: May, 1897, to December, 1899. Staff-Sergeant, R.A.M.C. (T.F.). Enlisted September, 1914. Western Front, May, 1915, to December, 1918.

Proceeded overseas in command of "A" Battery, 281st Brigade R.F.A., September, 1915; subsequently commanded 17th, 235th and 75th Brigades, R.F.A.; twice wounded, Somme, 1916, Langemarck, 1917; awarded D.S.O., 1st January, 1918; three times mentioned in despatches.
